The first record of the portuguese indie rock band Não Simão is an EP of 5 songs to show the voice and the capacity of writing poems by Simão Palmeirim. The lyrics bring a deep way to write portuguese poems with a particular sound ambience created by the musiciens. Songs that wander between intimacy and optimism.

They claim to be denial of boredom, prosaic, predictable, with uncompromisingly serious music resulting from a motley quintet that travels between songbook music, alternative rock, or jazz.

Together since 2013, they have passed through numerous venues and national festivals. They are part of the collection New Talents Fnac 2015. In artistic residency during the year 2017 at Irreal, in Lisbon, they invited for collaborations musicians like Manuel João Vieira, Carlos Barretto, Marta Miranda (OqueStrada), Magdalene Palmeirim, João Berhan, among others.

Their songs give great importance to the written word where lyrics are in Portuguese. The musical richness goes from the intimate song pop, rock or the challenge to dance a humorous ska.
